Things to Keep in Mind



Ideas are plentiful.

However, those ideas which can be patented, produced, marketed and sold at a profit are not.

DON'T

Don't respond to late-night TV commercials and ads in do-it-yourself magazines.



DON'T

Don't seek the help of invention development companies, particularly those asking for money to be paid BEFORE assistance is given.



DO

<u>**Do</u>** get advice from impartial parties. Organizations do exist that can evaluate a product for a reasonable fee.</u>



DO

Do visit or join inventors clubs, such as i^3 .

These groups can offer impartial, if not professional, advice.



DO

<u>Do</u> seek professional legal advice from a patent attorney or patent agent when applying for a patent (claims).



DO

<u>Do</u> a *preliminary* patent search yourself (no cost) at a **Patent Depository Library**(PDL):

- Ilinois State Library (Springfield) (217) 782-5737
- St. Louis Public Library (Downtown) (314) 539-0390

*It is best to call for an appointment before visiting either PDL.

DO

<u>Do</u> research and consider the various types of patents for your idea:

- Provisional
- Utility
- Design



In some cases, the best protection may be **something other than a patent**.

Trade Secret?

Finally, let's dispel a myth!



A prototype is *not required* for a patent application, although a working model might be helpful to you.
